About the Speaker

Dr Vanessa Raymont's interests are in traumatic brain injury, cognitive disorders and dementia, as well as clinical trials in cognitive impairment. She is currently working as part of the EPAD (European Prevention of Alzheimer's Dementia) Consortium to establish a pan-European network of Trial Delivery Centres to undertake Proof of Concept secondary trials for prevention of Alzheimer's dementia. Dr Raymont has a Masters degree in Cognitive Neuropsychology from University College London, and completed specialist training in general adult, old age and neuropsychiatry at the Maudsley Hospital and the Institute of Psychiatry in London. She is a senior researcher and honorary consultant psychiatrist in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Oxford, and at the Centre for Dementia Prevention in the University of Edinburgh's Centre for Clinical Brain Sciences.

Overview of Webinar

The presentation will focus on how research is helping develop strategies for reducing risk for, or even preventing dementia. This will include current preventative studies running (e.g. PREVENT Dementia, European Prevention of Alzheimer's Dementia, Deep and Frequent Phenotyping) as well as current clinical service commentaries that are bringing preventative strategies close to clinical implementation (e.g. The Edinburgh Consensus 2017; <https://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pmc/articles/PMC5657110>).
